

Daffodil Place offers the comforts of home to people with cancer and their families who must travel to St. John's for cancer care. The 24 rooms are designed specifically for those living with cancer.

Available Supports

Daffodil Place provides meal services, emotional support and access to information on all aspects of cancer care. Transportation to care facilities and appointments is available.
