### Scent free

## What is Daffodil Place?

Daffodil Place is a 24-room facility, operated by the Newfoundland and Labrador Division of the Canadian Cancer Society, for people with cancer and their caregivers who must travel to St. John's to receive cancer care.

## Who can stay?

To stay at Daffodil Place, potential guests must meet the following criteria:

- Must live a minimum of 50 kilometers outside of St. John's.
- Must be undergoing active cancer treatment, which includes: radiation therapy, chemotherapy, specialists appointments related to cancer (dentistry, dermatology), surgery related to cancer, follow-up appointments with oncologists and diagnostic appointments.
- Guests are required to provide medical documentation.

## How do I make a reservation?

- Reservations for accommodations are made on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to availability and verified through the health care system.

## Accommodations

There are 24 guest rooms available at Daffodil Place, each with a private bathroom. Ten rooms are furnished with two single beds, while the remaining 14 rooms have one queen-size bed, including two fully wheelchair accessible rooms.

Each room also includes:

- Telephone with local calling
- Satellite television
- Internet access
- Small refrigerator
- Linens and towels

Laundry facilities are available to guests, free of charge, for personal items.

## Cost

Guests are charged a fee of \$30.00 per night for one person and \$20.00 per person thereafter. Included in this fee is:

- Accommodations for a patient, caregiver or loved one.
- Three hot meals per day plus snacks.
- Transportation to and from the guest's cancer related appointments/treatments.

## Staff

Daffodil Place has staff on site 24 hours a day. There are no medical personnel on site.

## What should you bring?

Daffodil Place offers many of the comforts of home, however we ask that guests bring along certain items to help during their stay:

- Toiletries and personal hygiene items.
- Any necessary medications or medical devices.

We ask that guests leave valuables at home.

## Length of stay

Guests are able to stay at Daffodil Place for the duration of their cancer related appointments/treatments. Guests may arrive one day prior to the commencement of their treatment and must check out the day following the conclusion of their treatment.

## Cancellation policy

Please cancel reservations as soon as possible so that we are able to accommodate others. A minimum of 24 hours notice is preferred.
